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



#### **SKR2 Timeline – Submission**





- Trying to submit your proposal at the very last minute increases the likelihood of mistakes (e.g., forgetting to submit mandatory documents) or esa-star malfunctioning/taking longer to load. This can lead to rejection!
- IN CASE of esa-star malfunction, collect proof of your submission (i.e., take print screens of the error appearing) and contact IT immediately DON'T WAIT FOR THE CALL TO CLOSE, submit at least 24h prior


## SKR2 Timeline vs. Proposals

#### SKR2 Timeline vs. Proposals – TOB





- 3 proposals were considered non-admissible at TOB as key information was missing from the cover letter which barred us from assessing key acceptance factors (e.g., activity type and respective ceiling price)
- The cover letter is a contract PLEASE DON'T DELETE OR MODIFY ANYTHING IN THE TEMPLATE



- 3 proposals were considered non-admissible at preliminary assessment because they were not compliant with the K.A.F. of the call e.g., exceeding the 20% budgetary limit that applies to non-Slovak entities
- Please read the invitation to tender and the cover letter carefully and make sure to comply

#### **Lessons Learnt from the TEB (C1)**



- 1.1 Technical objectives: this section should be 1 paragraph only. It can even be a single sentence. In this section, you should define a single objective (instead of providing us with the motivation or listing the technical steps, for ex.)
- 1.2 Requirements: you should aim to provide requirements that are specific, quantitative ("timely manner" or "small enough" are not good requirements), and verifiable (how are you going to show us that your project was successful?)
- 1.4.4 Implementation aspects: this section is not a repetition of the technical steps. You should present a 1<sup>st</sup> iteration of the baseline design/concept (e.g., a block diagram), discuss trade-offs, and how the proposed work will be validated and the objective demonstrated.

### Lessons Learnt from the TEB (C2 and C3)



- 1.6 Prospect For Exploitation And Use: still one of the main downfalls of our proposals; in this section you should aim to describe if your proposal will lead to a Slovak participation on an optional program (if so, which one?) and if it will lead to product/service (even at a low TRL).
- 1.3 TRL: please be reasonable when assessing your start/target TRL level and don't go for a Type B purely for budgetary reasons (the maximum budget for Type A was increased for SKR3). This will result in a down mark in both C2 and C3.
- 3.2 Detailed Price Breakdown: Please remember that if the activity type requires co-funding, it cannot come from other public R&D funding sources. This can lead to the rejection of your proposal!
